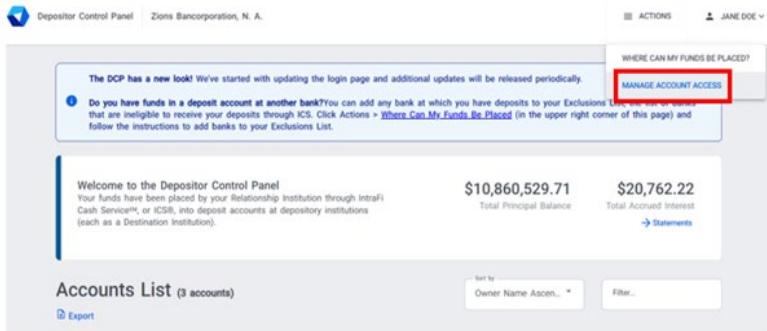


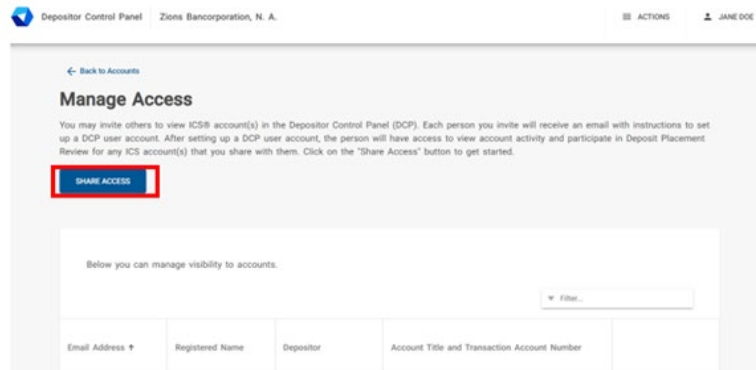
INTRAFI DEPOSITOR CONTROL PANEL: SHARING ACCESS

The Depositor Control Panel (DCP) is a secure website created to help you manage your IntraFi Cash Service account(s). This guide explains how to authorize multiple individuals to access your ICS account(s) in the DCP. Each person you authorize to access the account will create a unique username and password. Authorized individuals may view account activity and participate in Depositor placement review, including rejection of proposed placements.

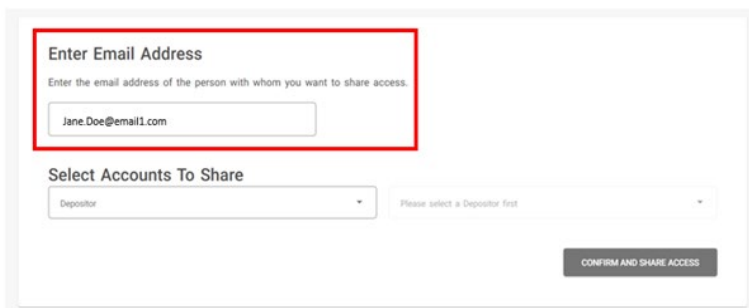


DCP HOME PAGE

1. Click *Actions*.
2. Select *Manage Account Access*.



3. Click *Share Access*.



4. Enter the email address of the person with whom you want to share access.

5. Select the accounts to share.

6. Select the account from the Account Title and Institution Transaction Account Number field.

7. Click *Confirm and Share Access*.

You will receive a confirmation that you have successfully shared access once you submit the invitation.

Click the *Remove Access* link to remove access at any time.

Deposit placement through CDARS or ICS is subject to the terms, conditions, and disclosures in applicable agreements. Although deposits are placed in increments that do not exceed the FDIC standard maximum deposit insurance amount (“SMDIA”) at any one destination bank, a depositor’s balances at the institution that places deposits may exceed the SMDIA (e.g., before settlement for deposits or after settlement for withdrawals) or be uninsured (if the placing institution is not an insured bank). The depositor must make any necessary arrangements to protect such balances consistent with applicable law and must determine whether placement through CDARS or ICS satisfies any restrictions on its deposits.
